

## MORE THAN A VEST SUPPLY LIST

### Materials:

1 ½ yds 45-54" outer fabric  
1 ½ yds 45-54" lining

**OR**

1 1/8 yds 60" outer fabric  
1 1/8 yds 60" lining

¼ yd interfacing (can be pre washed muslin)  
½ yd binding

### Supplies:

Sewing machine in good working order, instruction manual, thread to match your fabric, wound bobbins, walking foot, scissors (fabric & paper), pins, tape measure, pattern tracing paper, pencil, rotary cutter, mat, ruler, 3 buttons, 3 sets ½ " diameter snaps (size 3)

If you choose to quilt your fabric, I suggest that you use flannel as batting. Machine quilt your 3 layers, then wash and dry at least twice. You will need 2 quilted pieces that are the size listed below

S 6-8	36" x 25" L
M 10-12	37" x 25" L
L 14-16	38" x 26" L
XL 18-20	39" x 26" L
XXL 22	40" x 27" L

(These are **minimum** sizes after washing)

For success with your first vest, try using a decorator fabric, instead of quilted patch work. I personally pre shrink all of my lining, especially the polyester silkies, and the decorator fabrics. These will all shrink. Then I steam press them. The poly will shrink a little more. Don't use a hot iron.
