### All Entries – Guidelines and Procedures:

1. Entries must be (a) quilted, (b) made of fabric, (c) finished, and (d) in good condition.
2. Quilts must have a 4” sleeve attached to the top of the back of the quilt. The sleeve should end 1 ½” in from each side of edge of the quilt.
3. Entries must be free of odors and debris.
4. A paper label (provided on the website, to be printed and filled in) must be sewn to the quilt back on the lower right side. Please sew the label inside of garments, the inside or bottom of bags/totes.
5. Non-judged entries must be hand delivered with label and sleeve sewn on, by Thursday, October 6, 2022, between 8am and 10am to ARD Regional Park, Richardson Drive, Auburn, CA
6. Notify Teri Sartain at 530-863-0391 immediately if one or more of your entries must be withdrawn from the show.
7. Entries must be picked up Saturday, October 8, 2022, between 5pm and 6pm at ARD Regional Park. You must present your receipt to claim your entries.
8. Entries previously entered in the 2021 virtual show may entered in the 2022 show for display only. These entries will not be eligible to be judged or Viewers choice or Members choice voting.

### Judged Entries:

1. Judging will take place on Wednesday, October 5, 2022 at the Parkside Church.
2. Judged entries must be delivered to the Parkside church between 8:00 and 9:30am on Wednesday, October 5, 2022.
3. Judged fee of \$10 will be collected for each item entered to be judged. Make checks payable to FQG.
4. The judge must be able to view the back of the quilt.

5. Judging will be conducted using the “elimination method”.
6. A scribe will be assigned to each judge who will record comments of the judges. The comments will be returned to the exhibitor at the close of the show.
7. Entries will be judged anonymously.
8. The judging committee reserves the right to move an entry to a different category or return the judging fee if the entry cannot be judged fairly.
9. Remember, if your quilt is professionally quilted, please indicate two-person quilt and provide the quilters name.

### **Category Definitions:**

- **Art:** Extends beyond the traditional and innovative disciplines, using personal expression and originality in design, color or technique.
- **Applique (Hand or Machine):** Applique predominates over piecing or other techniques in either amount or effect.
- **Bag/Tote:** A bag or tote constructed using fabric and quilting techniques.
- **Miniature:** Miniature versions of large quilt. All parts of the quilt should be in proportion, including piecing, quilting, borders, and binding. Quilts should be no larger than 24”x24”.
- **Modern:** Emphasizes simplicity, minimalism, and/or asymmetrical designs.
- **Pictorial:** Represents a recognizable image of a person, place or thing; may be whole cloth, painted, applique, collage or any number of techniques.
- **Pieced:** Piecing predominates over applique or other technique either in amount or effect.
- **Traditional:** Based on traditional style patterns.
- **Wearable:** Fashionable and wearable garment constructed using quilting techniques.
- **Other:** Items not covered above - Whole Cloth, Embroidery, Fiber art, etc (describe)
