**Sewing machine**

Your manual, pedal and power cord along with bobbins, oil, needles, tools, and feet  
Name tag  
Patterns and fabrics

**Tools and notions:**

Rotary cutter(s), new blades, rulers, threads, scissors, stiletto, seam ripper, pins, pencil, pens, and/or markers, teflon sheets (if you are doing appliqué that is heat set). (There will be **cutting stations** with mats for your use, if you prefer not bringing your own.)

**Irons:**

Several ironing stations will be set up. To avoid overloading the circuits in the facility, we ask that you use one of the ironing stations unless you are using an iron similar to the Clover mini iron used in starch appliqué. (approximately 20 Watts)

**Snacks and beverages:**

*Spill-proof* cup or capped water bottle for your beverages  
Finger foods or snacks to share in a resealable container or individually wrapped

**Lunch:**

We suggest that you consider either going out for lunch or bringing your lunch in an insulated lunch bag to keep it cool. Please provide your own beverage(s).
